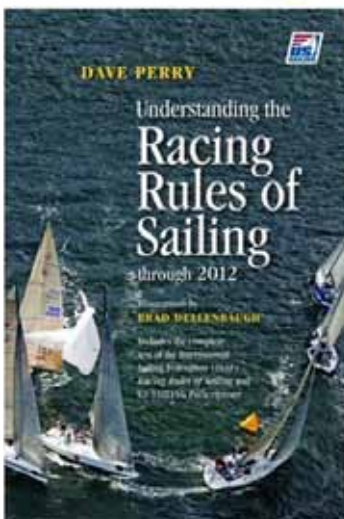

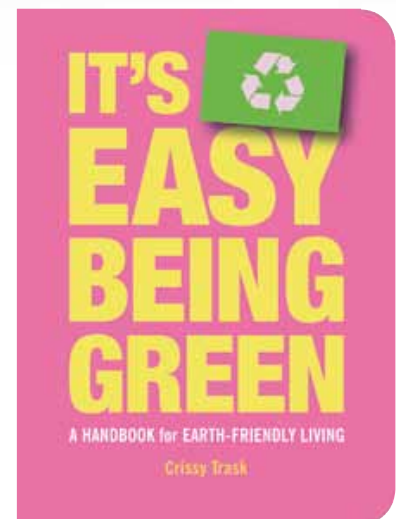

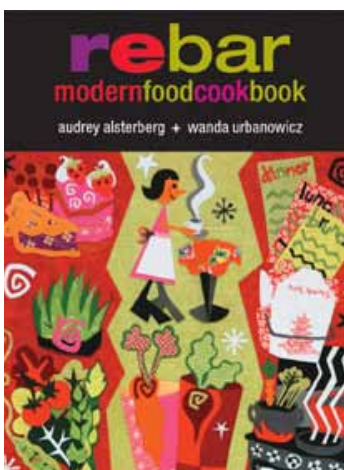


It's Easy Being Green: A Handbook for Earth-Friendly Living

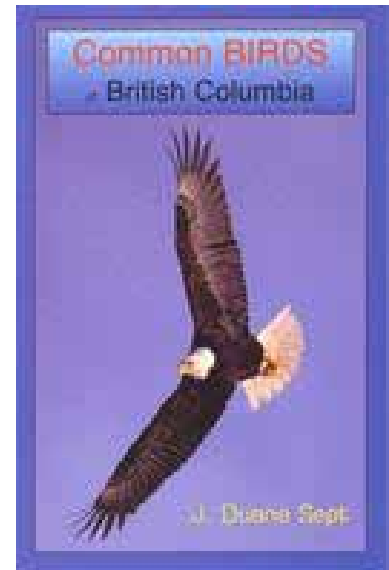

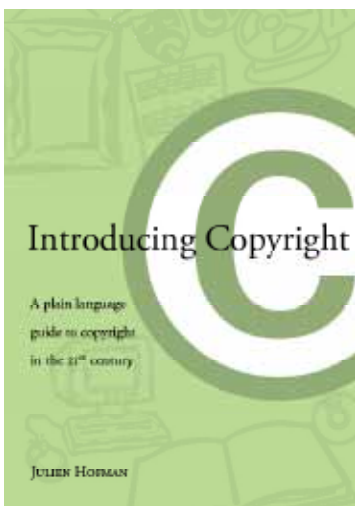
