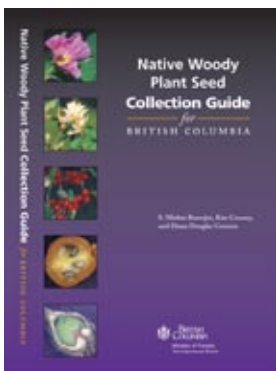

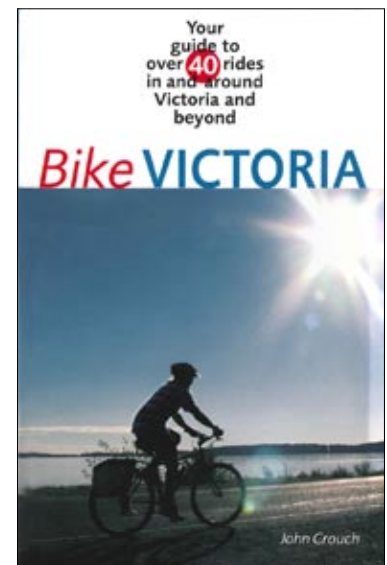

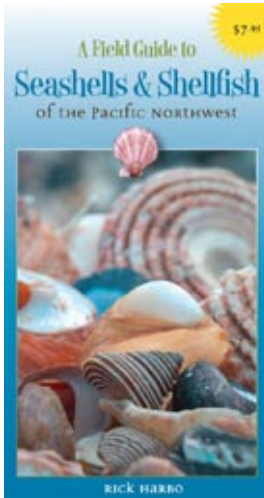

A user-friendly guide for all ages!

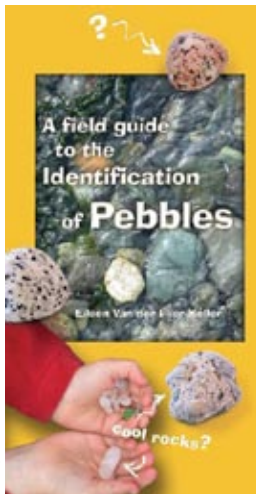

### Field Guide to the Identification of Pebbles

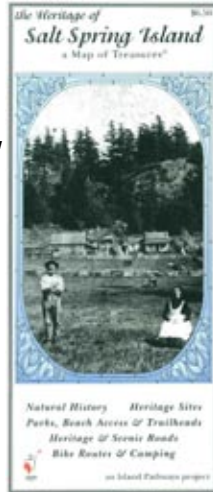
