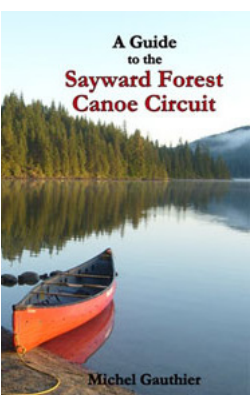
Bannock and Beans: A Cowboy's Account of the Bedaux Expedition

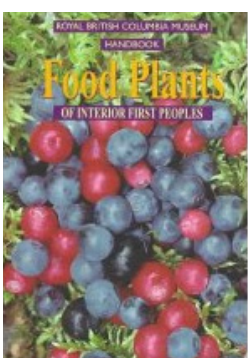
A Guide to the Sayward Forest Canoe Circuit

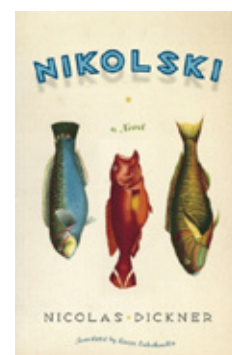
Fall On Your Knees

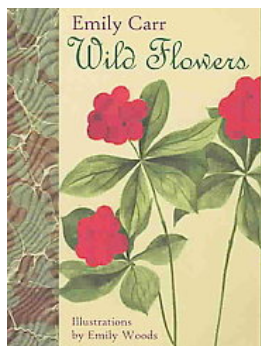

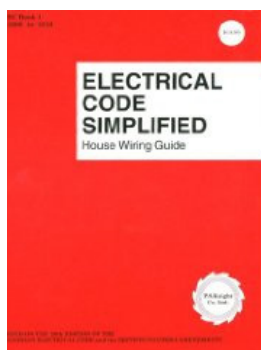

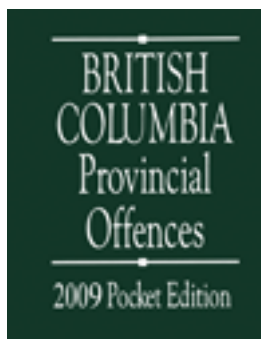
